

Terms of Assignment to the Alternative School

The following behaviors must be adhered to while your child is assigned to the Alternative School. Failure to comply with these terms may result in your child being expelled from school for the remainder of the semester.

- _____ 1. Absences – shall not miss school, except for medical reasons.
- _____ 2. Tardiness – shall not be late to school unless brought to school and checked in by the parent / guardian.
- _____ 3. Shall not create any disturbances / distractions that would interfere with a teacher's right to teach and the other pupil's right to learn.
- _____ 4. Shall be prepared each day for class. Each day the student will report to class with the materials designated by the teacher.
- _____ 5. Shall not participate in or attend any extra-curricular activities during the time the student is assigned to the Alternative School, which may be held off campus.
- _____ 6. Shall not drive a vehicle to the home school or to the Alternative School while assigned to the Alternative School. The student shall ride the bus to the home school and transfer to the Alternative School bus at designated pick-up place. Misbehavior on the bus to the home school and to and from the Alternative School may result in expulsion from school.
- _____ 7. Shall provide restitution to the school district for damages and/or theft prior to the end of the current school year. If restitution is not made in the time designated by the school, the student will not be allowed to enroll for the succeeding school year.
- _____ 8. Discipline – The student shall follow the rules of conduct established for the Alternative School. Failure to do so shall result in a recommendation for expulsion for the remainder of the semester. This includes misbehavior on the school bus to the home school and to and from the Alternative School.
- _____ 9. The parent shall meet with the Alternative School staff after the student's assignment to plan cooperative interventions for the student.

_____ 10. The parent shall attend parenting workshops if the principal and counselors deem it necessary.

_____ 11. The student and/or parent will participate in the services provided by the county-wide Title I Social Worker and other professional counselors on a periodic basis.

_____ 12. Upon return to your child's home school, he/she will be on probation for the remainder of the _____ school year.

The earliest date this student can return to his/her home school is _____.

Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the Alternative School will result in the extension of time the student is assigned to the Alternative School.

If the student transfers, drops out, or is expelled from the Alternative School, he/she will be reassigned to the Alternative School upon his/her re-entry into the school district and will complete the time for which he/she was originally assigned to the Alternative School.
